





 METHOD OF PROCESSING AND DATA RETENTION	Data processing is carried out with the aid of electronic tools and / or paper supports. The data will be kept for a period not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are collected and processed and in compliance with the mandatory times prescribed by law and in any case for ten years after the last registration to fulfil administrative and fiscal obligations.												
 RECIPIENTS OF THE DATA	Personal data may be disclosed to: i) consultant and freelance professionals; ii) subjects delegated to technical maintenance; iii) banks and lenders; iv) public and / or private subjects to whom the communication of data is mandatory for legal obligations or functional to the relationship; v) person in charge delegated by Musumeci S.p.A. to the processing of data.												
 RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT	Articles from 15 to 22 of the GDPR give the data subject the exercise of specific rights, including: right of access by the data subject, right to rectification, right to erasure ("right to be forgotten"), right to restriction of processing, right to data portability, right to object, right to object to automated processing including profiling. To exercise these rights, you must contact us at the contacts included in this information. Furthermore, the data subject can lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority, if he or she believes that the processing that concerns him or she violates the law in force (Article 77 of the GDPR).
